Writ Petitions under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in these circumstances stated therein and in the respective affidavits filed therewith the High Court will be pleased to

(i) issue appropriate writs, orders or directions and in particular a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the 1st respondent to promote the writ petitioners to the post of Junior Engineer Grade I in the respondent Corporation w.e.f. the date their immediate junior was promoted and grant further promotions accordingly together with the monetary, pay fixation and other service benefits with arrears (in WP.1871/2014) and

(ii) pass an interim direction directing the 1st respondent to promote the writ petitioners to the post of Junior Engineer Grade I in the respondent Corporation (in MP.1/2014) pending WP No.1871/2014

respectively.

Order : These petitions coming on for orders upon perusing the petitions and the respective affidavits filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of MR.K.SRINIVASA MURTHY FOR M/S.ROW AND REDDY, Advocate for the petitioner in both the petitions, the court made the following order:-

It is seen that, on the earlier occasion, this Court was pleased to allow the writ petitions filed by the petitioners against which Writ Appeal has been filed by the official respondents. The subject matter of the earlier writ petitions pertains to the promotion to the post of Junior Engineer Grade II. Now, the present writ petition is filed seeking direction to the respondents, to promote the petitioners to Junior Engineer Grade-I. The entitlement of the petitioner would depend upon the order to be passed in the Writ Appeal. Considering the same, this Court is of the view that this writ petition would be posted along with Writ Appeal in W.a.No.1573/2012, after getting appropriate orders from My Lord, the Hon'ble the Chief Justice.

Interim order of status-quo, already granted is extended for a period of one week.
