I am to inform that In the Government Order first and second read above, orders were issued for implementation of New Health Insurance Scheme , 2021 for Employees to provide Health Care assistance on a CASHLESS basis for the beneficiaries under New Health Insurance Scheme.

In the reference fifth cited, the United India Insurance Company has fixed the time limit for the submission of reimbursement claims pertaining to New Health Insurance Scheme 2021 for Employees stating that, as per the revised regulations of the industry and department of Financial services guidelines, pending claims of the previous year and books of accounts needs to be permanently closed on or before 120 days from the date of expiry of such policy and once closed, these claims cannot be reopened. These guidelines need to be strictly adhered to without any deviations and violation failing which, the United Insurance Company Limited is liable for administrative repercussions from the regulatory bodies.

In this regard, in the reference 7th cited, the Government have informed the United India Insurance Company Limited that in respect of the settlement of reimbursement claims pertaining to the treatment taken from 01.07.2021 to 30.06.2023 for employees, the time limit may be extended as per the schedule detailed below:

Cut off date for submission of reimbursement claims by the Employees (through their Head of Office / Head of organization).	To submit the application in the respective offices before 31.10.2023
Cut off date for forwarding the reimbursement claims to United India Insurance Company Limited by the es / Head Office / Head of Organizations.	As and when received, the concerned offices has to forward reimbursement applications to United India Insurance Company Limited immediately. Final cut off date for forwarding the reimbursement applications – Before 10.11.2023.

The applications decided by the United India Insurance Company Limited as ineligible for reimbursement shall be returned to the concerned individuals informing them to place the cases in District Level Empowered Committee.	As per Government Letter (Ms) No.30465/Finance(HI)/2022-1 dated: 17.09.2022 Settlement has to be made within a period of 30days from the receipt of applications. If the claim is not eligible under this scheme the same has to be returned to the petitioners with the proper reason within a period of 15 days. Therefore, all in eligible claims shall be returned to the concerned individuals before 25.11.2023
Cut off date for the submission of appeal petitions to the concerned Joint Director of Health Services for placing the claims in District Level Empowered Committee.	15.12.2023
District Level Empowered Committee has to be conducted for the aboveclaims	Before 10.01.2024.
Cut off date for forwarding the claims decided in DLEC under scenario I and II payable by the United India Insurance Company Limited	Before 25.01.2024

In this regard, the Heads of Organizations are requested to take necessary action on the following:

- 1) To communicate the above time limit regarding the submission of reimbursement claims pertaining to the treatment taken from **01.07.2021 to 30.06.2023** for employees under New Health Insurance Scheme to the notice of the Employees working under the organizations concerned.
- 2) To display the communications in the notice board.
- 3) To forward the relevant required medical documents related to the claims received from the employees to the United India Insurance Company Limited within the time limit prescribed.

This may be treated as most urgent.
