Sub: TANGEDCO – Vigilance Cell – Establishment – Procedure followed in disposal of scraps – Reiterated Orders - Issued.

In the circular memo first cited,

All the Chief Engineer/Superintending Engineers concerned were instructed to review all the Registers available in stores especially supply of materials, meters, cables etc., once in three months without fail. They were also informed, in future one officer in the rank of Assistant Executive Engineer from Vigilance Cell Unit or Enforcement Wing will be deputed with one Police Official apart from Circle. Assistant Executive Engineers for witness during the disposal of Scrap materials from Stores.

2. In the reference second cited,

- i. The concerned Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers were instructed to depute the concerned Assistant Executive Engineer/ Enforcement who comes under their administrative control for witnessing the disposal of scrap material from the stores available in the Distribution areas only with an intimation to the concerned Executive Engineers/Enforcement and to the Superintending Engineer/Enforcement and also instructed to depute the concerned Assistant Executive Engineer/Vigilance Unit or any officer available by the concerned Vigilance Officers in respect of other than Distribution area (viz). Thermal Power Stations, General Construction Circles, Generation Circles etc., for witnessing the disposal of scrap materials in the stores.
- ii. After disposal of scrap, the report should be sent to concerned Vigilance Officers/Superintending Engineer/ Enforcement and Executive Engineer/Enforcement under intimation to Vigilance Cell.

- iii. Further, it is also instructed to check that the scrap materials available should be weighed and recorded by the Executive Engineers concerned and the same should be recorded in the respective register at the time of disposal to the contractor. This matter will be reviewed after 3 months.

3. The above norms are not strictly followed by the Chief Engineers and Superintending Engineers which amounts to non-compliance of the orders of the Board. Hence, the above orders are reiterated for strict adherence in future.

4. In addition to the above, all Chief Engineer/Distribution Regions and Chief Engineer/Thermal Stations are directed to state whether the scraps under their jurisdiction are disposed off by following the E-auction method or otherwise. If so, state the procedures followed in disposing scrap materials immediately by return E-mail.
