Sub: TNPDCCL – Engagement of additional manpower during Monsoon 2025 for 10 Regions (Except Chennai and Kancheepuram Regions) – Approval of CMD – Instructions – Issued.

Ref: 1. Proposal submitted by the Chief Engineer/Personnel.
2. CMD/TNPDCCL note approval dated 25.10.2025.

Based on the proposal submitted by the Chief Engineer/Personnel, the CMD/TNPDCCL has accorded approval for engaging additional manpower, as per the PWD Schedule of Rates, to ensure the quick restoration of power supply during the ensuing Monsoon 2025, by attending to breakdowns and resolving power supply interruptions promptly in the 10 Distribution Regions (Except Chennai and Kancheepuram Regions (except Tiruvallur Electricity Distribution Circle), subject to the following conditions:

1. Period of Engagement:

Engagement of additional manpower is permitted for about 90 days (i.e., from 01.11.2025 to 31.01.2026).

2. Rationalization of Manpower:

The number of manpower per section shall be rationalized as follows:

- a. 4 Nos. per Section in vulnerable Circles (such as Coastal areas).
- b. 2 Nos. per Section in other Circles, wherever essentially required.

3. Maintenance of Records:

The concerned Chief Engineers/Superintending Engineers shall maintain comprehensive records relating to the engagement and utilization of the additional manpower for the purpose of billing. The details shall be consolidated and communicated to the CFC/General without fail.

4. Accounting and Billing Procedure:

To regulate and close the expenditure towards the engagement of additional manpower, detailed instructions for accounting and billing procedure will be devised and communicated separately by the office of CFC/General to all field offices.

All field officers are strictly instructed to adhere scrupulously to the accounting and billing procedures so prescribed. Any deviation or non-compliance with these instructions will be viewed seriously and dealt with strictly in accordance with the rules in force.

All concerned Chief Engineers are hereby directed to ensure meticulous compliance with the above instructions and to take necessary action strictly in accordance therewith.
