Sub: Utilising the services of retired personnel in power supply restoration works – Further Instructions – Reg.

It is a well known fact that among other Districts, Cuddalore District is the worst affected due to Cyclone "Thane". Even though all measures are taken to restore power supply on war footing, the restoration works are getting delayed due to dearth of adequate workforce.

As an interim measure, it has been decided to utilise the valuable services of willing field staff, who have retired during the past five to six years period in the cadre of Helper, Wiremen, Line Inspector, Foremen, JE-II Gr, JE-I Gr and AEs. The remuneration may be fixed as below:

- Helper - Rs.300/- per day
- Wireman - Rs.350/- per day
- Line Inspector/Foreman - Rs.500/- per day
- JE-II Gr./JE-I Gr./AEs. - Rs.600/- per day.

Superintending Engineer/Cuddalore EDC shall obtain the details of the retired personnel immediately and utilize their services as above, within 2 days.

All other Superintending Engineers shall also depute retired field staff available in their Circle to Cuddalore immediately so as to report to the Special Officer/Cyclone Restoration (Thiru T.Senthilvelan - 9445852280) at Cuddalore.

The food and shelter shall be provided by making local arrangements.
